¹⁵⁶ Castrén writes that he crossed the Arctic Circle on 25 June, but this seems impossible if he was in Övertorneå on 26 June.

The lists have been compiled on the basis of Castrén's travel reports and diaries and letters from 1838–1849 as well as J.R. Bergstadi's travel diary of 1845–1846 and folk poetry collected by Castrén in the *Suomen kansan vanhat runot* database, <https://skvr.fi>. All places are referred to with the names used in Castrén's time, giving the present-day name in brackets where different. If the form used by Castrén himself is the only one that is known, it is given in *italics*. The dates in Finland, Sweden and Norway are given according to the Gregorian calendar (new style, n. st.), and the ones in Russia according to both Julian and Gregorian calendars (old and new styles, o. st., n. st.), as far as can be determined which calendar Castrén used. Dates are given dd. mm. yr.
